Length of Program



- 46 week program
- From the beginning of January to mid-November each year
- Coincides with Orthopedic Residency Program
- 1-4 residents accepted, dependent upon staffing, space

Weekly Schedule



- 40 hours per week patient care (M-F)
- 4.5 hours one on one mentoring included in this time, one morning per week
 - Usually on Tuesday or Thursday
- 3 hours didactic and lab time in addition to the 40-hour work week
 - Usually on Wednesday morning or Friday afternoon

Mentoring



- The resident will treat his/her patient, and the mentor will observe
- The mentor will ask questions and provide feedback to challenge the resident's clinical reasoning skills
- This is the most important part of residency

Tuition, pay, benefits



- For outside applicants:
 - Tuition for the program is \$3,500
 - Pay is hourly rate for entry level PT, no benefits

Curriculum Overview



Modules:

- Urogynecology (January, February)
 - Female pelvic floor dysfunction: bladder, bowel, pain
- Orthopedic (March, May)
 - Spine and hip
- Pregnancy and postpartum (April)
- Special topics (June, July, August)
 - Male, pediatric, Neuro, Osteoporosis, Female Athlete, Middle age/Menopause
- Breast cancer, lymphedema (September, October)

Impairments, patient population



Pelvic floor disorders

Urinary incontinence, urinary urgency and frequency, urinary retention, pelvic organ prolapse, fecal incontinence, constipation, post pelvic radiation

Pelvic pain

Pelvic girdle pain, myofascial pain, dyspareunia, vulvar pian disorders

Pregnancy and postpartum

Back and pelvic pain, diastasis recti, obstetric perineal injuries

Pre- and post-surgical

Gynecological, prostatectomy, abdominal surgeries

Application Process



- Application open in preceding August
 - ABPTRFE site
 - Essay, 3 letters of recommendation
 - IL PT license (by start of program in January)
 - CPR certification
- Interviews and selection of applicants in September and October
 - Usually a one-hour interview
- Program starts in first full week of January

WCS Board Exam



- Apply in July of residency program year
- Take exam following March
- 100% pass rate (13/13) as of September 2025
